## 4. Describe the purposes of your organization:

The Mission of The West 78<sup>th</sup> Street Museum Block Association shall be to preserve and enhance the community and aesthetic character of the Museum Block of West 78<sup>th</sup> Street. It shall promote effective communication and social activities among all residents and actively support maintaining and improving the appearance, safety and well-being of its trees, plantings and sidewalks.

The enhancement of the physical beauty of the block will continue as a central task of the Association. This include professional planning, planting and care for trees, flowers and sidewalks along the block, as well as maintaining an aesthetically harmonious neighborhood character.

The Association will set up and manage an interactive website whereon Members may access information concerning the neighborhood's interests. The website will be used to initiate and monitor block-wide activities, as well as provide information concerning regulations and events affecting the block within the Upper West Side community.

The Association will work closely in collaboration with Public School 87 on issues affecting its pupils and faculty in order that the school becomes an active participant in block affairs.

# THE WEST 78TH STREET MUSEUM BLOCK ASSOCIATION

### A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ASSOCIATION FORMED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

#### ARTICLE I -- OBJECTIVES

The Association is organized exclusively for charitable purposes to fulfill its Objectives as stated in its Articles of Association.

No part of its net revenues shall inure to the benefit of its members or other private persons. It shall not carry on any propaganda activities nor otherwise attempt to influence legislation and shall not participate in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

It shall only engage in activities permitted to an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Upon dissolution, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code.

#### ARTICLE II - MANAGEMENT, DIRECTORS and MEETINGS

The Association shall be managed by a board of directors consisting of the three founding directors initially selected by its pre-existing Executive Committee. Each director shall hold office until their replacement is selected or elected or they retire. The number of directors may be increased or decreased at any time by a vote of a majority of all of the directors. Any director may be removed for cause by action of the board.

The board may hold its meetings in person or electronically at any place or time as it may determine. A majority of the entire board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. A vote of a majority of the directors present at the time of the vote shall be the act of the board.

Present members of the Association's preexisting Executive Committee, as created in the original Constitution of this Association dated 6 June 1972 and subsequently enlarged, shall serve as members of the newly reconstituted Board. In the absence of a board meeting, acts of the Executive Committee shall be acts of the Board.

The board may appoint such officers as it may determine. Any two or more offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of president and secretary.

The Association shall hold harmless and indemnify its directors and officers against all expenses and liabilities reasonably incurred in connection with any proceeding to which he may be made a party, except in such cases wherein the director or officer is adjudicated guilty of willful malfeasance in the performance of his duties.

These Bylaws may be adopted, amended or repealed by an act of the board at any time.

### ARTICLE IV -- MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTIONS

All persons owning or occupying property on the block are eligible to belong to the Association.

Meetings of the entire Association are intended to be sporadic and called on an as-needed basis in order to address specific issues of importance to Members. Affairs of the Association are informally managed unless a formal meeting is called and elections among members are held. Directors and officers are expected to remain active until they resign or are replaced.

These Bylaws are hereby adopted by the Association's initial Directors.

## MEMORANDUM & ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION FOR AN UNINCORPORATED NONPROFIT ASSOCIATION

## THE WEST 78<sup>TH</sup> STREET MUSEUM BLOCK ASSOCIATION

1. NAME The West 78<sup>th</sup> Street Museum Block Association.

2. **OFFICE** The registered office of the Association is in New York City.

**3. OBJECTIVES** The Objectives of the Association shall be to preserve and enhance the community and aesthetic character of the Museum Block of West 78th Street. It shall promote effective communication and social activities among all residents and actively support, maintain and improve the appearance, safety and well-being of its trees, plantings and sidewalks.

4. **POWERS** The Association shall exercise the following powers and limitations:

4.1 The Association is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including the furtherance of its Objectives and making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

4.2 No part of the net earnings of the Association shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons.

4.3 No part of the activities of the Association shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor participating in any political campaign or related activity.

4.4 Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Association shall only carry on activities permitted by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c)(3).

4.5 Upon dissolution of the Association, its assets shall only be distributed to the New York City Parks Department for exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

### 5. BENEFITS TO MEMBERS AND DIRECTORS

5.1 The property and funds of the Association may be used only for promoting the Objectives and do not belong to the members of the Association.

5.2 The Association shall indemnify any person who is a member, director or agent of the Association against expenses of Association–related litigation.
